

## CCW Meeting Minutes February 20, 2018

Elaine and Bev Mollberg will assist with this but do not wish to chair. **WE NEED SOMEONE TO COME FORWARD TO CHAIR THIS EVENT.** Elaine has detailed list of things to do. If no one comes forward, we will have to run this event by committee with participation from many members. It was discussed to purchase bowls and foil pans and hand these out to women who will volunteer to make salad and bars. We will note each bowl or pan with the designated salad or bars needed. Then women can choose bowl or foil pan with the designated item and bring in. We will keep bowls/pans for following years. By doing this, we hope that we will not have to prepare salads beforehand as a group.

Elaine stated that Progressive Dinner will be held Friday, April 27. Sacred Heart will be providing dessert again. Expecting to serve about 100 people. Bev Mollberg and Mary Ann Drevecky will prepare dessert. Elaine will be doing decorations. Our church will need to sell tickets. Sue made motion that CCW cover costs incurred by Sacred Heart for food and decorations. Jan seconded. All agreed and motion carried. Progressive Dinner proceeds go to A Place For You, homeless/transitional shelter in Pine City.

Sue brought up participation in Discipleship Sundays. That this is not just for Faith Formation families but all families in parish. From Treasurer's report, it does not appear that dinners prepared for a Place for You have been taken out of CCW account as agreed to in motion in previous meeting. Sue will talk to bookkeeper to be sure that this is being done. She said that Confirmation students and families have been participating in this. She would like to see more involvement from parishioners. Dinners are usually prepared after fellowship after Youth Mass on second Sunday of month.

Sue reminded members of Tony Melendez concert on Feb. 21 at Pine City High School.

Jan brought up the poor condition of the high chairs in Wey Hall. Jan made a motion that CCW purchase two new high chairs. Audrey seconded. All in favor and motion carried. These could be purchased through Amazon and delivered to parish house.
