

CCW MEETING MINUTES FOR April 17, 2018

Meeting called to order at 6:30pm in Wey Hall. In attendance: Mary Ann Drevecky, Elaine Robinson, Jeanne Kay, Audrey Larson, Mary Jane Dahl, Bernie Winters, Ceil Shinler, and Sue Roth. We began with an opening prayer.

Secretary's Report – Sue presented meetings minutes from February Meeting. No changes made

Treasurer's Report – Jeanne- Current Balance as of 4/17/2018 is \$4987.74. Steve Yurick notified her that corrections needed to be made as payments for Unbound had not been taken out of CCW funds and also groceries for dinners for A Place For You had not come out of CCW funds previously. These have now been corrected and this is the reason for the lower amount. Also high chairs have been paid for. Motion made by Mary Jane to accept treasurer's report, second by Audrey. All agreed. Motion carried.

Old Business:

1. Progressive Dinner – Friday April 27, 2018 Elaine stated that 14 tickets have been sold, we still have more to sell. She stated Dave Prickett has agreed to say a prayer. Elaine is working on getting volunteers to help her serve on Friday night. (If you can help, please contact Elaine). Mary Ann will be leading a group to prepare the dessert on Thursday, April 26. This will begin at 9:30 am in kitchen. (If you can help, please contact Mary Ann.)
2. Salad Luncheon – Thursday May 17, 2018 Elaine presented a long list of duties that need to be done. We no longer have a chairperson so this will be lead by committee. Sue will make up a volunteer list for these duties and put in back of church and ask people to sign up for duties they could do. Sue volunteered to purchase bowls and foil pans. She will discuss with Bev Mollberg amount of salads and bars that are needed to be donated. Bowls/pans will be distributed after mass asking parishioners to make the salads/bars requested. Also announcements should be made at church providing information regarding this, as well as notices in bulletin. We will still need to get together to prepare items for Salad Bar and veggie pizza, so kitchen workers will still be needed day before as well. (If you can volunteer to help with Salad Luncheon, please contact Elaine Robinson or Sue Roth)

It was also suggested that name tags be made up for all volunteers so that those involved can be identified by our visitors, but also so all volunteers can get to know each other. Sue will see if parish secretary can make these from list of volunteers.

3. High Chair replacement – they have been purchased and Al Walz kindly assembled them. They are now available for use in Wey Hall.
4. Prayer Shawls – Discussion about inventory of these and that they are not getting distributed. Suggestion to tie this in with prayer list on bulletin. Also discussion on prayer list in bulletin needing to be updated. Sue stated that this had previously been discussed and she would follow up with office regarding this and linking Prayer Shawl Ministry with prayer list. Also will look into having prayer shawls available in back of church with prayer/note attached to them for parishioners to take.
5. Food Shelf – reminder that food shelf drive is every 2nd Sunday. Will ask office to automatically include notice of this in Sunday bulletin prior to this week. Please avoid outdated donations, although the food shelf does still offer these. Envelopes are available in the back of church for monetary donations as well.
6. Church cleaning – thank you to all those that participated. Other areas around the church and parish house will be cleaned/organized in upcoming months.

New Business:

Motion was made by Ceil, seconded by Audrey that CCW purchase gifts (\$10-15) for children making their First Communion on May 6, Confirmation on May 15, and Graduates on June 3. All agreed. Motion Carried.

Sue asked the group if CCW would be interested in starting to host breakfast again for Graduates. This has been done in the past but has not been done for a few years. Interest was shown, so Sue stated she will contact families of graduates and see if they would be interested in this as well. Suggested that Egg Bakes be brought in and baked during mass. Also purchase fruit/rolls. Motion made by Ceil that breakfast be organized by CCW, seconded by Mary Jane. All agreed. Motion carried. (Sue has contacted families and majority are interested in attending – so this is a go.)

Sue stated that last night of Faith Formation would be May 9. This night begins with praying of Rosary in Grotto at 6:30. Sue encouraged all members and parishioners to attend. She asked if CCW would be interested in hosting refreshments after in Wey Hall. Usually a cake and some fruit is provided. Jeanne made motion that CCW host this, Elaine seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

Mary Ann stated that Kitchen Inventory/Kitchen Cleaning will be held Thursday, May 3 at 9:00 am. Audrey, Sue stated they would be able to help. (If you are able to help, please contact Mary Ann Drevecky.)
