The Church of the Sacred Heart will be celebrating our "Fall Dinner and Raffle" on Sunday, September 20, 2020. Due to the COVID virus and our wish to keep us all safe, we will be doing things a bit differently than in past years. We will be having a raffle and take-out dinner only. We hope everyone will take this opportunity to come together, in a different way, to support our church and have a bit of fun too.

Our day will begin with a special Liturgical Celebration of the Eucharist at 10:00am. Dinner will be served after mass from 11:00am to 1:30pm. This will include chicken prepared by the Brass Rail and all sides to be prepared by Marsha Marcussen. Tickets are included here for \$12.00 per adult and \$6.00 for anyone 10 and under.

Our raffle will have all cash prizes and each ticket will be \$5.00 or 5 tickets for \$20.00 (one free ticket) and they are included herein. We ask every family to purchase or sell these tickets. All proceeds will go towards the Church of Sacred Heart general fund. The raffle will conclude our celebration at 2:00 p.m. Please return the purchased or unsold ticket(s) to the Parish House in an envelope, or in the collection basket during Mass, or in the drop box at the top of the ramp, by the weekend of September 12th and 13th. Additional tickets will be available at the Parish House and after Masses. Please pick up additional raffle tickets to sell to your family and friends. This is an important fundraiser for our parish! Envelopes are also available in church or at the Parish house to make a monetary donation to help defray the costs of the meal.

All parishioners are asked to volunteer in some way to help make this event a success. We will have drive-thru take out using the door at the northwest corner of the church. Watch for directional signs. Help is needed filling the takeout containers, serving, and running meals to the cars.
