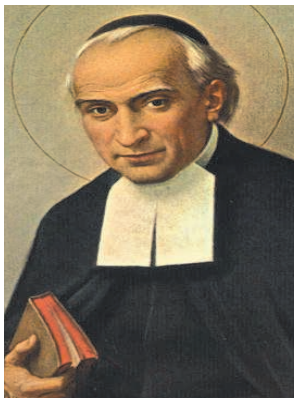

ST JOHN BAPTIST DE LA SALLE—FEAST DAY APRIL 7

Saint John Baptist de La Salle was a French priest, educational reformer, and founder of the Institute of the Brothers of the Christian Schools.

He was born in Rheims, France on April 30, 1651 to a wealthy family that ran a successful winery business. La Salle was named canon of Rheims Cathedral when he was sixteen. He was sent to college where he pursued higher studies and received a Master of Arts degree. When he had completed his courses, he was sent to Paris to enter the Seminary.



His mother died in 1671, and in 1672 his father died. This circumstance obliged him to leave the Seminary. He was now twenty-one, the head of the family, and as such had the responsibility of educating his four brothers and two sisters. He completed his theological studies and was ordained to the priesthood in 1678 at the age of 26. Two years later, he received a Doctorate in Theology.

During a chance meeting with Monsieur Nyel he became interested in the creation of schools for poor boys in Raven where he was stationed. Though the work was extremely distasteful at first, he became more involved in working with the deprived youths. Convinced that this was his divinely appointed mission, John left home and family, abandoned his position as canon at Rheims, and gave away his fortune, which reduced him to the level of the poor to whom he devoted his entire life.

John did not escape experiencing many trials: heart-rending disappointment, defections among his disciples, and the bitter opposition from the secular schoolmasters who resented his new and fruitful methods. He knew that the teachers in Rheims were struggling, lacking leadership, purpose, and training, and he found himself taking steps to help this small group of men with their work. First, he invited them to take their meals in his home, which was as much about teaching them table manners as inspiring and instructing them in their work. This crossing of social boundaries was one that his relatives found difficult to bear. When De La Salle realized that he would have to take a further step; he brought the teachers into his own home to live with him. De La Salle's relatives were deeply disturbed, his social class was scandalized. When his family home was lost at auction because of a family lawsuit, De La Salle rented a house into which he and the handful of teachers moved.

In 1685, De La Salle founded what is generally considered the first school whose purpose is to train teachers in Rheims, France. De La Salle was a pioneer in programs for training lay teachers. His educational innovations include Sunday courses for working young men, one of the first institutions in France for the care of delinquents, technical schools, and secondary schools for modern languages, arts, and sciences. His writings have influenced educational practice, school management, and teacher preparation for more than 300 years.

Afflicted with asthma and rheumatism in his last years, he died only three weeks before his 68th birthday on Good Friday April 7, 1719. Pope Leo XIII canonized him on 24 May 1900. Because of his life and inspirational writings, Pope Pius XII proclaimed him patron saint of teachers.

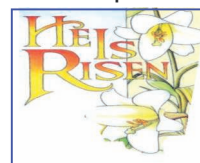

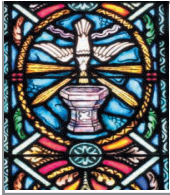


Youth Can Drive

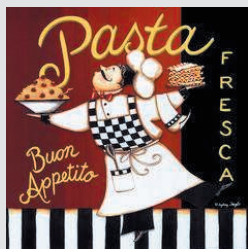

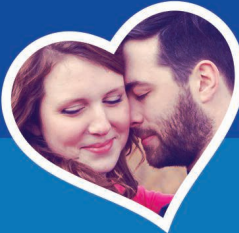
