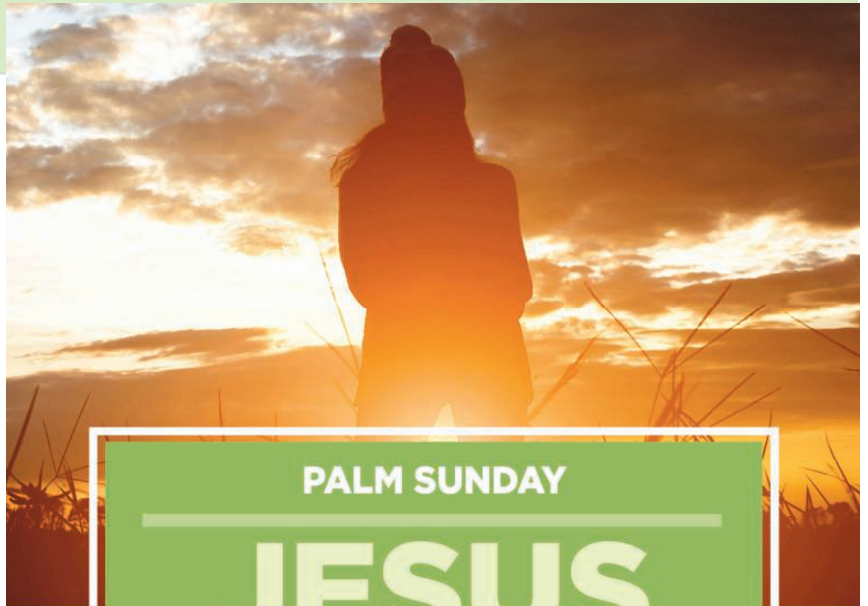

WEEKLY REFLECTIONS

On Going to Brother Emmanuel's Funeral- Part I

Like most of us nowadays, when the telephone rang in the office Monday, March 7, and I didn't recognize the caller, I was tempted not to answer it. On the last ring, the Holy Spirit told me to answer the call. The caller on the other end was Brother Bede, OSB, Cam., indicating that he had some sad news about Brother Emmanuel. He informed me that my uncle died the previous morning after suffering a heart attack. He had not been feeling well since taking a fall in late February. I asked Brother Bede when the funeral Mass was planned; he said that they weren't certain since many sections of the roads in all directions from the Hermitage were presently closed. Rockslides had occurred on Coastal Highway 1 as well as on the road through the Lucia Mountain Range, which was the only other way to get to the Hermitage.



Later on that day, I received an email from Father Cyprian Consiglio, OSB, Cam., the Prior (superior) of Brother Emmanuel's religious community of New Camaldoli Hermitage in the Big Sur area of California. The Camaldolese are a branch of the Benedictines founded by Saint Romuald in Tuscany, Italy in the late tenth century. The community in Big Sur, the first for the community in the USA, was founded in the 1950s. Anyway, Father Cyprian not only sent me an obituary of my Uncle, but also shared with me that they did not know the date of his funeral for certain. I wrote back telling him that I

would like to come to the funeral Mass.

After three days, I was informed that the funeral would be the following Friday. I told Father Cyprian that I would, in fact, come, and wrote that I would stay at the Hermitage a day or two. It just so happened that – again the Holy Spirit was at work in my life- a few months earlier, I had arranged to take the next weekend off and already had coverage for the Masses at both parishes. Having made my arrangements to fly to San Jose and then drive to the Hermitage, I informed the Prior that I would arrive on Friday morning, the day of the funeral. He suggested that I come in with his assistant Jason, the funeral directors, and the hearse who would be coming on Friday morning since the roads were still dangerous and rough along the route and only locals were being allowed in the area. I could either ride with them or follow; I chose to be part of the motorcade, and to leave from King City where I would be spending the night.

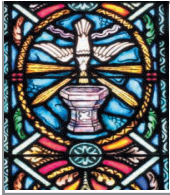

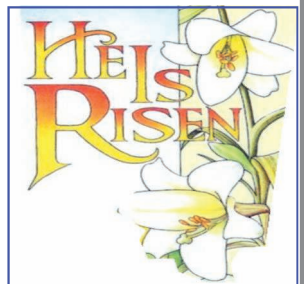

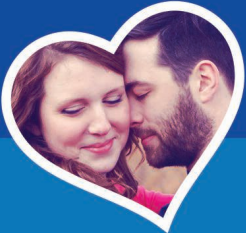
